## Ennis opponent named For July 29<sup>th</sup>. Nine big bouts set for KEA Boxing Philly blockbuster card

A spectacular night of boxing, promoted by Andre Kut's KEA Boxing Promotions is set for the South Philly Asylum Arena on Friday July 29<sup>th</sup>. Headlining the card is the comeback of former USBA junior middleweight champion, Derek "Pooh Ennis (22-3-1, 13KO's) who is ready to make another run towards the elusive world title bout. He first must get by dangerous Mexican knockout artist Saul "Baby" Duran (38-18-2, 31KO's) in the eight round main event of the evening..

Ranked number ten by the IBF, Ennis knows a victory on Friday night will put him right back on his path to his world title aspirations. The 30 year old from the Germantown section of Philadelphia is a slick boxer with deceptive power which leads to exciting fights. Two of his last three bouts are Philly fight of the year nominations. Ennis put together two crowd pleasing victories over cross town rival "King" Gabriel Rosado and Jose Gonzalez which had everybody on their feet throughout both bouts.

It will be no easy night for Ennis as Saul Duran provides explosive power with thirty one knockouts in his thirty eight victories. Duran has tested some of the best contenders in and outside of Mexico and owns a victory over the legendary Hector "Macho" Camacho.

Undefeated Philly featherweight sensation Coy Evans (10-0-1, 2KO's) looks to continue his winning ways in the six round co-feature of the evening against dangerous Columbian, Felipe Almanza (18-26-4, 9KO's). Both fighters know each other well, having fought in January with Evans pulling out the unanimous decision victory, so expect fireworks right from the opening bell.

KEA Boxing's heavy handed welterweight sensation, Juan Rodriguez Jr. (6-0, 3KO's) of Union City, New Jersey returns to action in a six round contest against Philly's own Greg Hackett (2-8).

Crowd pleasing Philly welterweight prospect, Ardrick "The Hit Man" Butler (6-4, 3KO's) is also set to battle it out in a six rounder against Oxford, North Carolina's William Wilson (8-7, 4KO's).

If heavyweights are your choice, you will love MAK Boxing's Latin knockout artist Jose Luis Roque (3-0, 3KO's), who take on an opponent to be announced. The twenty-four year old Miami resident returns after a two year layoff and looks to show the Philly fans the explosive knockout power that has sent all of his previous opponents packing inside of the distance.

Several other four round bouts, featuring some of the area's finest talent are set for the undercard.

Undefeated heavyweight John "The Breed" Lennox (5-0, 2KO's) of Carteret, New Jersey is set to swap punches with Alexandria Virginia's Antonio Robertson (0-2-1).

Philly heavyweight Georgiy Garulnik (1-0) will look to remain perfect when he battles over four rounds with Washington DC's Damian Richardson (0-2).

Harrisburg PA super bantamweight Josh Bowles (1-0) is set to tangle with Cyprian Khumalo (0-1) in a four round contest.

Rounding out the card will be a four round junior welterweight featuring Tyrone Crawley Jr. against Ohio native Corey White (1-2, 1KO).
